Case Experience

Moore v Scenic Tours Pty Ltd

Case Summary

The class action against Scenic Luxury Cruises & Tours (officially Moore v Scenic Tours Pty Ltd) concluded in 2023 with a landmark settlement of approximately \$26 million, ending nearly a decade of litigation. The case is legally significant because it reached the High Court of Australia and redefined how “disappointment and distress” damages are treated under Australian Consumer Law (ACL).

Legal Issue

The case was hard-fought because of a dispute over whether “disappointment and distress” qualified as “personal injury.”

The Conflict: Scenic argued that disappointment was a form of “mental harm” (personal injury), which under the Civil Liability Act 2002 (NSW) requires a high threshold of “15% of a most extreme case” to qualify for compensation.

Outcome

After the High Court victory, the matter returned to the lower courts to determine the exact value of damages for the entire class.

Damages Breakdown: Each passenger’s compensation typically included a refund of the “reduction in value” of the cruise (often a significant portion of the ticket price) plus an additional amount for disappointment.

Final Settlement (2023): After 10 years of legal battles, Scenic agreed to pay \$23 million to the class members and \$3 million toward their legal costs.

Other Cases

Lindsey Schofield & Anor v TFS Manufacturing & Ors

Lindsey Schofield & Anor v TFS Manufacturing & Ors is a Federal Court of Australia class action regarding complications from Tissue Fixation System (TFS) pelvic mesh implants. A \$41.45 million settlement was approved on August 24, 2023, with AJB Stevens Lawyers appointed as administrators to manage claims for injuries.

Key Aspects of the Case:

Parties: Applicants Lindsey Schofield and Melissa Weedon sued TFS Manufacturing (and others), with Chubb acting as insurer.

Settlement: The Court approved a \$41.45M settlement on 24 August 2023.

Administration: AJB Stevens were appointed as administrators to manage the settlement scheme on 15 December 2023.

Scope: The action concerns injuries, loss, or damage resulting from complications with IVS and/or TFS pelvic mesh implants.

The settlement is designed to compensate group members for injuries caused by the devices, with individual claims assessed based on a questionnaire and registration process.
